OH&S Environment



- OH&S awareness training as a priority
- Construction Health and Safety Awareness Training (CHSAT) is not preceding as a requirement
- A need to provide base line construction OH&S awareness
- Contractors required to provide site safety orientation



The Requirements



- Establish a base level of knowledge
- Platform to deliver the program, confirm understanding, recognize and register the worker
- Use Program as a base level of understanding to further orientation and training including:
 - Site specific orientation
 - Subcontractor guidelines
 - Working at heights, etc.
 - Sharing of Best Practices



The Safety Pass



- Provides consistent, effective orientation for workforce
- Supports big picture objectives, like building safety culture
- Fulfills needs of contractors, subs and workers
- Reduces duplication of general awareness training
- Cost effective
- Efficient system delivery



The Ontario Solution: “The Safety Pass”



The Ontario General Contractors Association (OGCA) and Safety Committee leaders have developed a generic HSE orientation awareness program for construction.

The Safety Pass features:

- One-stop construction HSE orientation that is consistent and transferable
- Eliminates duplication of general HSE orientations
- Fully transferable, online registration, learning, testing and validation
- Focus to be on the actual project specific HSE orientation
- **TIME AND MONEY SAVINGS**

The Safety Pass...



- Is an interactive online program
- Contains 13 Modules and Quizzes that can be completed at a user's pace
- Requires a mark of 100% in order to receive a certificate of completion
- Once complete, a digital AND printable certificate will be issued through SkillsPass™—an online safety credential management platform (more on that later)
- Average user completes the course in 2 hours
- 3 year refresher required

Benefits



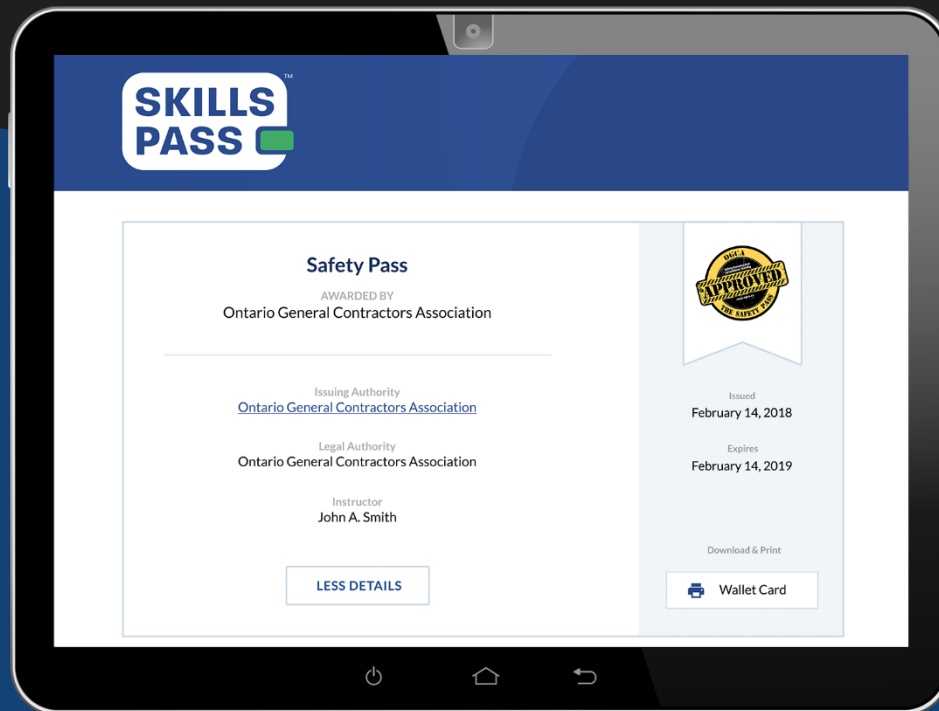
- The Safety Pass is fully transferable from site to site, avoiding duplication of generic HSE orientations.

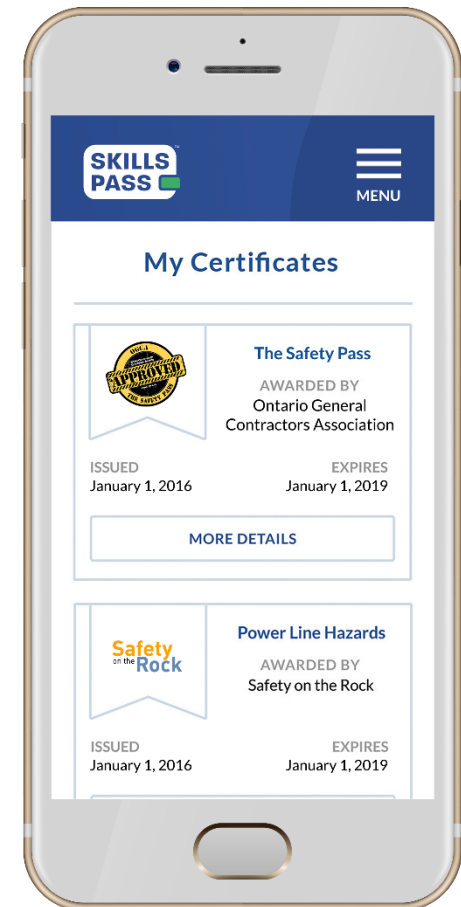

With SkillsPass™ your organization will have:

- Oversight of your entire workforce —employees and contractors and the status of their training
- Improved ability to validate safety and dispatch transient workers and sub-contractors.
- Will include the ability to easily demonstrate compliance of mandatory MOL programs
- Worker credentials that are not easily lost or misplaced.

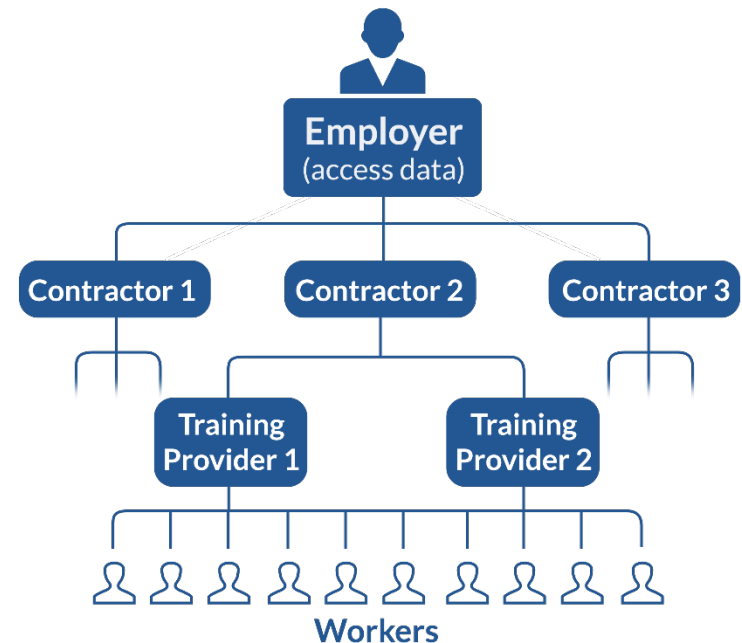


Employers | How it Works

The SkillsPass team will setup Employers and Contractors with their own accounts.

When a worker completes Safety Pass, a certificate is automatically used on SkillsPass. This online database gives employers access to:

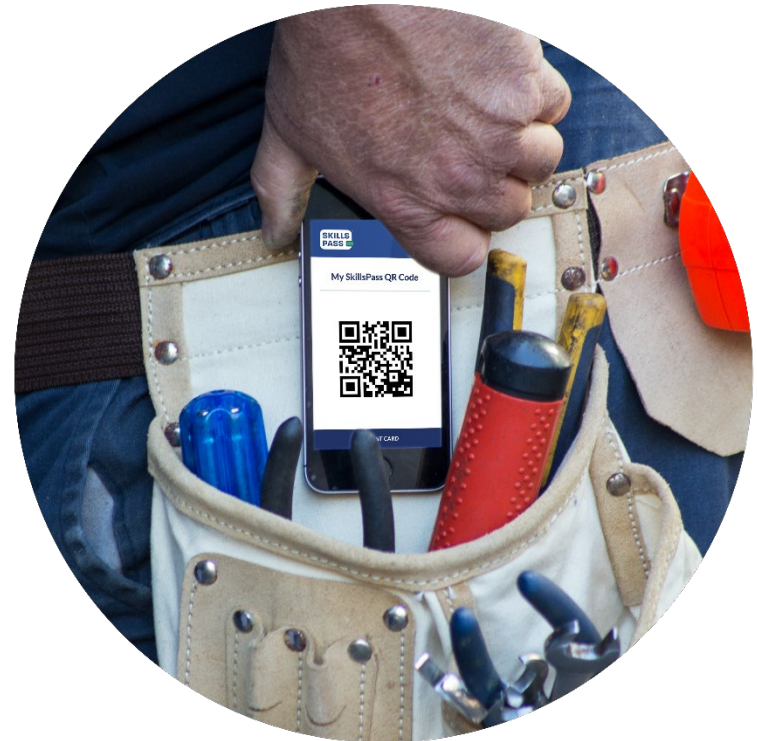
- Real-time, validated training credentials starting with The Safety Pass.
- Automatic notifications of upcoming expirations.
- Reports for all employees.
- Record checking made easy with QR code.



What does this mean for Workers?

Workers can focus on their work, not on their wallet cards.

- A worker will register on SkillsPass and create a user profile.
- Upon completion of The Safety Pass, each worker will have a digital certification.
- Worker can view, print, and/or share with multiple employers from SkillsPass.
- But even if they forget their card... the SkillPass QR code can be scanned by an employer for a complete picture of their safety credentials in real-time.

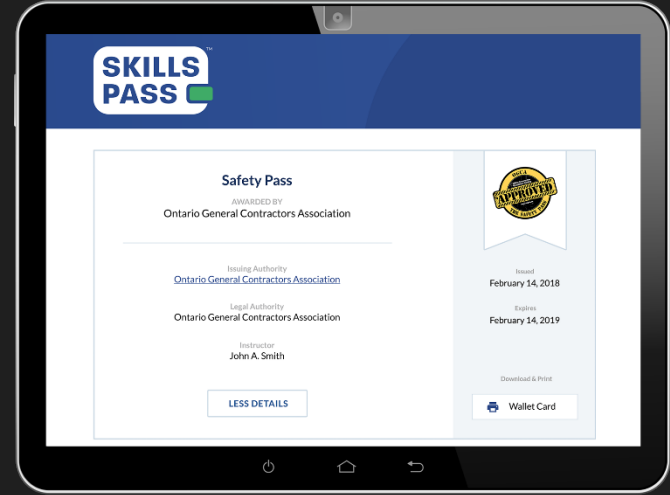
